

GRIMALDI FORUM MONACO

Ideally located and built on the sea front and just a few minutes' walk from the finest hotels in the Principality, the Grimaldi Forum Monaco is one of the first European Convention Centre with environmental certification. With its 35,000m² / 376,737 sq ft of usable floor space, it hosts all types of professional events: meetings, congresses, conventions, product launches, trade fairs & exhibitions for up to 3,000 people.

The Grimaldi Forum Monaco has gained international recognition from the Industry for the quality and adaptability of its infrastructures and the professionalism of its staff, making it without doubt the ideal setting for your next event, offering them unique character.

MAIN ENTRANCE

Esplanade Princesse Grace stretches across 1,700m² / 18,300 sq ft facing the sea. On it stands the main entrance to the Grimaldi Forum Monaco and the 1,500m² / 16,145 sq ft "Grande Verrière", the building's architectural signature.

AUDITORIA & MEETING ROOMS

- Salle des Princes: 1,800 seats with folding tables
- Salle Prince Pierre: 800 seats with folding tables & 350 classroom seats
- Salle Camille Blanc: 400 seats with folding tables & 177 classroom seats

- Espace Ravel: 4,205m² / 45,262 sq ft (with 2,546m² / 27,405 sq ft pillar-free) facing the sea with natural daylight
- Espace Diaghilev: $3,901\text{m}^2/41,990$ sq ft with a private entrance from Esplanade Princesse Grace.

FOYERS

The foyers in front of auditoria Prince Pierre and Camille Blanc, plus those outside the committee rooms, offer a total surface area of over 2,000m² / 21,528 sq ft. Great places for mingling!

CONGRESS DINING

- Le Guelfe (garden view) and Le Génois (sea view) each have a capacity of 450 people and a 590m² / 6,350 sq ft floor area. A central kitchen is at the disposal of selected catering company (From Grimaldi Forum Monaco's catering company approved list).
- Café Llorca is the chic bistro of star-rated chef Alain Llorca. It is open to the public during the day Mondays/Fridays and can be hired for a private function any day of the week. The restaurant serves local, Mediterranean cuisine (500 seated & up to 1,000 standing).
- Zelo's restaurant and bar-lounge overlooks the Mediterranean (200 place settings).





The Principality of Monaco enjoys a very privileged geographical location at the heart of Europe, less than a two-hour flight from major European capitals.

Nice Côte d'Azur International Airport is nearby, linked to Monaco by an array of transport options.

NICE CÔTE D'AZUR INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

France's second-busiest airport with over 11 million passengers per year, links the Principality of Monaco to over 100 destinations around the globe. 70 flights per day connect with Europe's main hubs.

Transfers between Nice and Monaco:

A helicopter takes off every 15 or 30 minutes depending on the season for a 7-minute flight between Nice and Monaco. A free shuttle bus is provided when arriving in the Principality.
